## TOUR O THE BORDERS CAMPSITE

2 - 3 SEPTEMBER 2023

Thank you for choosing to stay at the Tour O The Borders Campsite on September 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> September. This document contains important information for campers, so please read it through carefully.

We ask you to respect any requests and procedures described by staff — we do so for the safety and smooth running of the site.

<b>Contact on the day</b>	There will be a Campsite Manager on site to help deal with any questions or queries. In the event that they are not available, please head over to Tweed Green and ask for Hillside Outside Event Staff. Email <a href="mailto:info@tourotheborders.com">info@tourotheborders.com</a> with any questions ahead of the weekend.
<b>Venue</b>	Edderston Farm, Peebles EH45 9JE The campsite is on farm land and we recommend using what.3.words (exonerate.tempting.tilt) as this provides a more accurate location - <a href="https://w3w.co/exonerate.tempting.tilt">https://w3w.co/exonerate.tempting.tilt</a> The campsite will be sign posted from the centre of Peebles.
<b>Times &amp; checking in</b>	<u>Check in time</u> Between 3pm until 7pm on Saturday 2 <sup>nd</sup> September.  <u>Check out time</u> Until 6pm on Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> September.  Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field.  In an effort to save paper, you will not be required to print off a camping pass. Just ensure you have your email confirmation ready on your phone and show that to the Campsite Manager.
<b>Accessibility</b>	There will be an entrance/exit for vehicles, and a separate entrance/exit for leaving/entering the campsite on your bike. This will be well sign posted.
<b>Facilities</b>	Portable toilets will be available at the campsite. There is no electric hook up available. Water is available, but please note it is not officially drinking water.
<b>Conduct</b>	The campsite is located in a residential area; it is vital that you respect the neighbours and the land. You must leave the pitch as you found it and put all rubbish/recycling in the bins provided.

	<p>Noise must stop at 23:00 and vehicle movement is prohibited between 22:00 and 05:30.</p> <p>Gazebos/ezups are not allowed due to wind/safety considerations and there is a policy of strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames. Under 16s must be supervised by a responsible adult and dogs are allowed, but they must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.</p>
<b>Security</b>	<p>We take no responsibility for loss or damage to items left at the campsite. Please note that there will be no overnight security provided.</p>
<b>Smoking</b>	<p>The law in Scotland states that it is illegal to smoke in public places. The entire Event Village has been designated a no-smoking area for the duration of the event. If you wish to smoke, please do so off site and dispose of your cigarettes responsibly.</p>
<b>Local Amenities</b>	<p>The sites proximity to:</p> <p><u>Hospital</u> – there is a small injuries unit at HayLodge Medical Centre in Peebles EH 45 8JG. The nearest A&amp;E is at Borders General Hospital in Melrose.</p> <p><u>Fire Station</u> – Caledonian Road, Peebles, EH45 9DL.</p> <p><u>Public Transport</u> – nearest train station Galashiels Station. Bus service x 62.</p> <p><u>Parking</u> – As a camper, you don't need to book parking. If you have friends or family coming to cheer you on, they can book parking <a href="https://www.sientries.co.uk/event.php?event_id=10352">https://www.sientries.co.uk/event.php?event_id=10352</a></p> <p><u>Major Roads</u> – the site is just off the A72, about 28 miles south of Edinburgh. Directions to the campsite and the Event Village will be well signposted.</p> <p><u>Local Services</u> – the campsite is in Peebles, with local supermarkets, pubs, petrol stations, chemist, public toilets and cafes.</p>
