	will be limited, so it's always best to find someone at the Event HQ.

	By 10am on Monday 8 th September.
	Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field.
	In an effort to save paper, you will not be required to print off a camping pass.
	Just ensure you have your email confirmation ready on your phone and show
Accessibility	that to the Campsite Manager. There will be an entrance/exit for vehicles, and a separate entrance/exit for

	The campsite is less than 5 minutes away from the Event HQ on Tweed
	Green, EH45 8AP.
Facilities	Portable toilets will be available at the campsite. There will be lots more at
	the Event HQ on Tweed Green available for participants. There are also public
	toilets available at School Brae, Edinburgh Road Car Park, Hay Lodge park
	and Kingsmeadow Road car park. We would advise having change available
	for payment.
	There is no electric hook up available.
	Drinking water is available in the camping field.



Conduct	The campsite is located in a residential area; it is vital that you respect the neighbours and the land. You must leave the pitch as you found it and put all rubbish/recycling in the bins provided. Noise must stop at 23:00 and vehicle movement is prohibited between 22:00 and 05:30. Gazebos/ezups are not allowed due to wind/safety considerations and there is a policy of strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames. Under 16s must be supervised by a responsible adult and dogs are allowed, but they must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.
Security	We take no responsibility for loss or damage to items left at the campsite. Please note that there will be no overnight security provided.
Smoking	The law in Scotland states that it is illegal to smoke in public places. The entire campsite has been designated a no-smoking area for the duration of the event. If you wish to smoke, please do so off site and dispose of your cigarettes responsibly.
Local Amenities	The sites proximity to: Hospital – The nearest A&E is at Borders General Hospital in Melrose. Fire Station – Caledonian Road, Peebles, EH45 9DL. Public Transport – nearest train station Galashiels Station. Bus service X62. Parking – As a camper, you don't need to book parking. Major Roads – the campsite is just off the A72, about 28 miles south of Edinburgh. Directions to the campsite and the Event Village will be well signposted. Local Services – the campsite is in Peebles, with local supermarkets, pubs, petrol stations, chemist, public toilets and cafes.
