



Tour O The Borders Campsite Terms & Conditions 2025

We ask all of our campers to comply with our policies otherwise we may have to ask you to leave the site.

- * Camping pitches are allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- * One pitch per tent or vehicle.
- * Toilet facilities are available.
- * No electric hook up available.
- * Please note there's no gazebos/ez-ups allowed due to wind/safety considerations.
- * Strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames.
- * No noise in the camping field after 23:00.
- * Vehicle movement on the site is prohibited between 22:00 and 05:30.
- * Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field.
- * Under 16s must be supervised by a responsible adult
- * Dogs are allowed but must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.
- * Fire extinguishers are located at the gate of the camping field.
- * Campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers at all times.
- * Please consider other users of the site and we ask that all users always conduct themselves with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.
- * In the event of poor ground conditions, a pitch may not be available. The Event Organisers will endeavour to advise you in advance should this occur but no responsibility can be accepted if this is not possible.
- * In the event of poor ground conditions, a tractor will be available at agreed times to pull vehicles out – please note this is at the vehicle owner's risk. Kerfield Farm will not be liable for any damage caused.
- * Riders parking or camping at Kerfield Farm do so at their own risk. Kerfield Farm and Hillside Outside will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the property of the visitor, including personal belongings, bikes and motor vehicles caused during their camping stay.
- * The Event Organisers are not responsible for any misplaced, lost or stolen items.
- * Leave your pitch as you find it - respect the environment and please leave your camping pitch free of any litter.
- * You can bring alcohol, but please be responsible and respect others.
